Classification, Labelling and Safety Data Sheet Requirements in EU

Course Description and Objectives

Although the Globally Harmonised System of Classification and Labelling of Chemicals (GHS) has been implemented in both the US and the EU there are significant differences in each jurisdiction's regulations. In the EU the classification and labelling parts of the GHS are implemented through the CLP Regulation, whilst the safety data sheet requirements are implemented through REACH.

This course will outline the key requirements of CLP and REACH with respect to hazard communication and highlight the differences with Hazcom 2012. Practical exercises will be held throughout the course to reinforce the learning.

It is assumed that delegates will have a working understanding of the GHS classification, labelling and safety data sheet requirements in the U.S.
