Presentation abstract

The EU introduced new hazard classes into the CLP regulation for endocrine disruptors and persistent chemicals earlier this year. In addition, the requirements for nanomaterials continue to develop. This presentation will look at the current and forthcoming requirements in the CLP and REACH Regulations for hazard classification and communication, the impacts on other downstream regulations, and the development of tools and guidance to help companies comply with the ever-increasing complexity of the regulations for affected chemicals.
